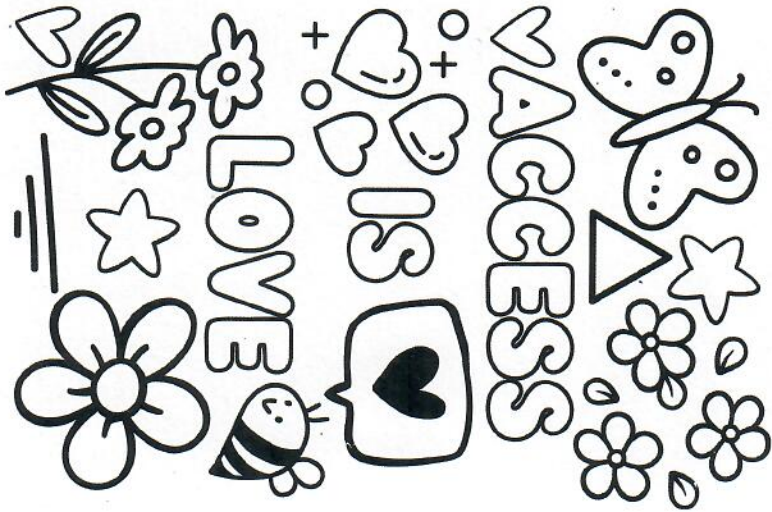




HOW DO YOU BUILD AN ACCESSIBLE WORLD?

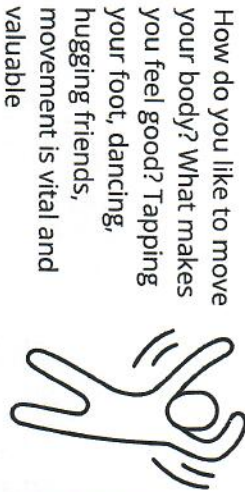

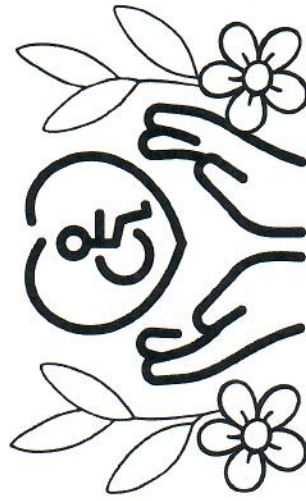
