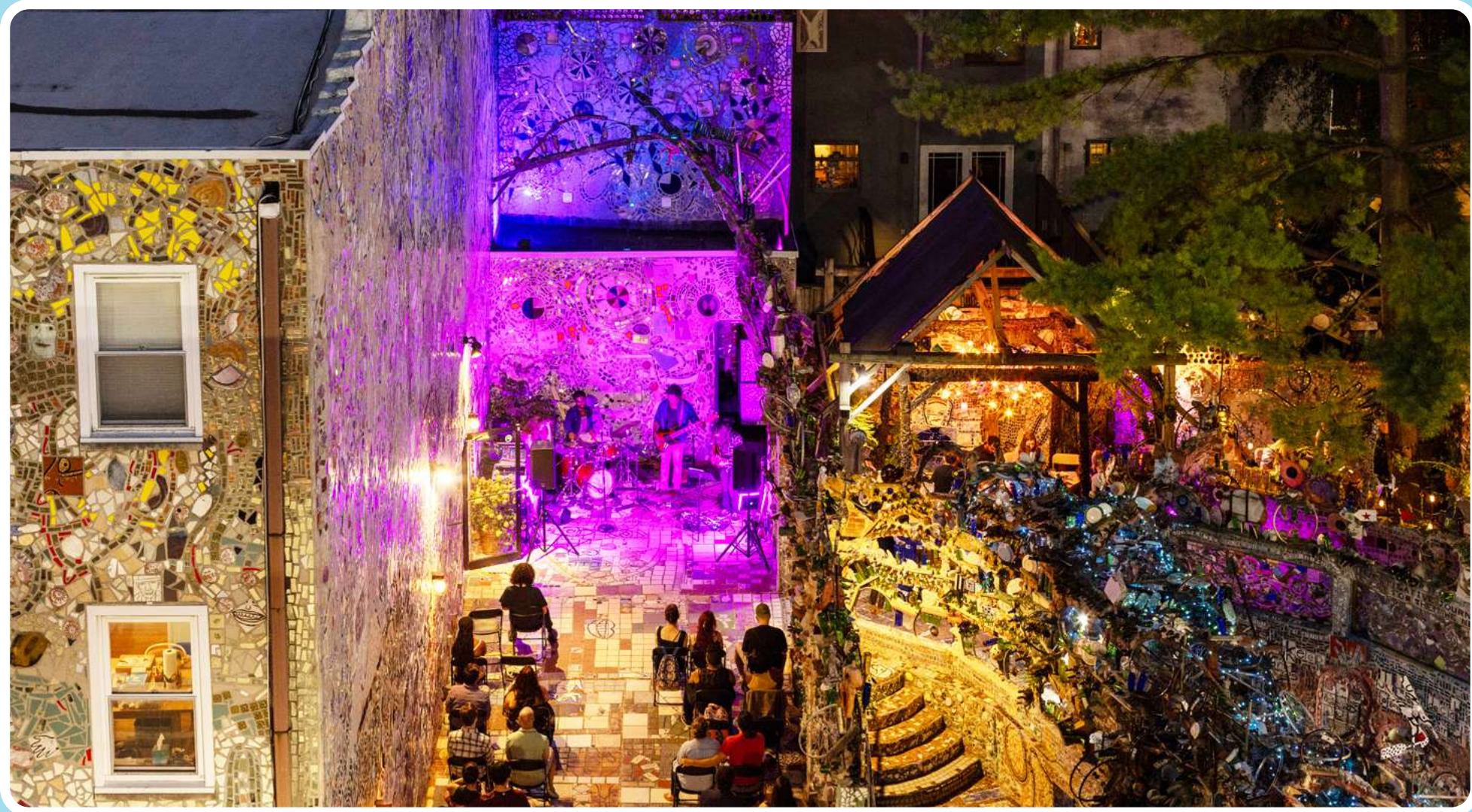

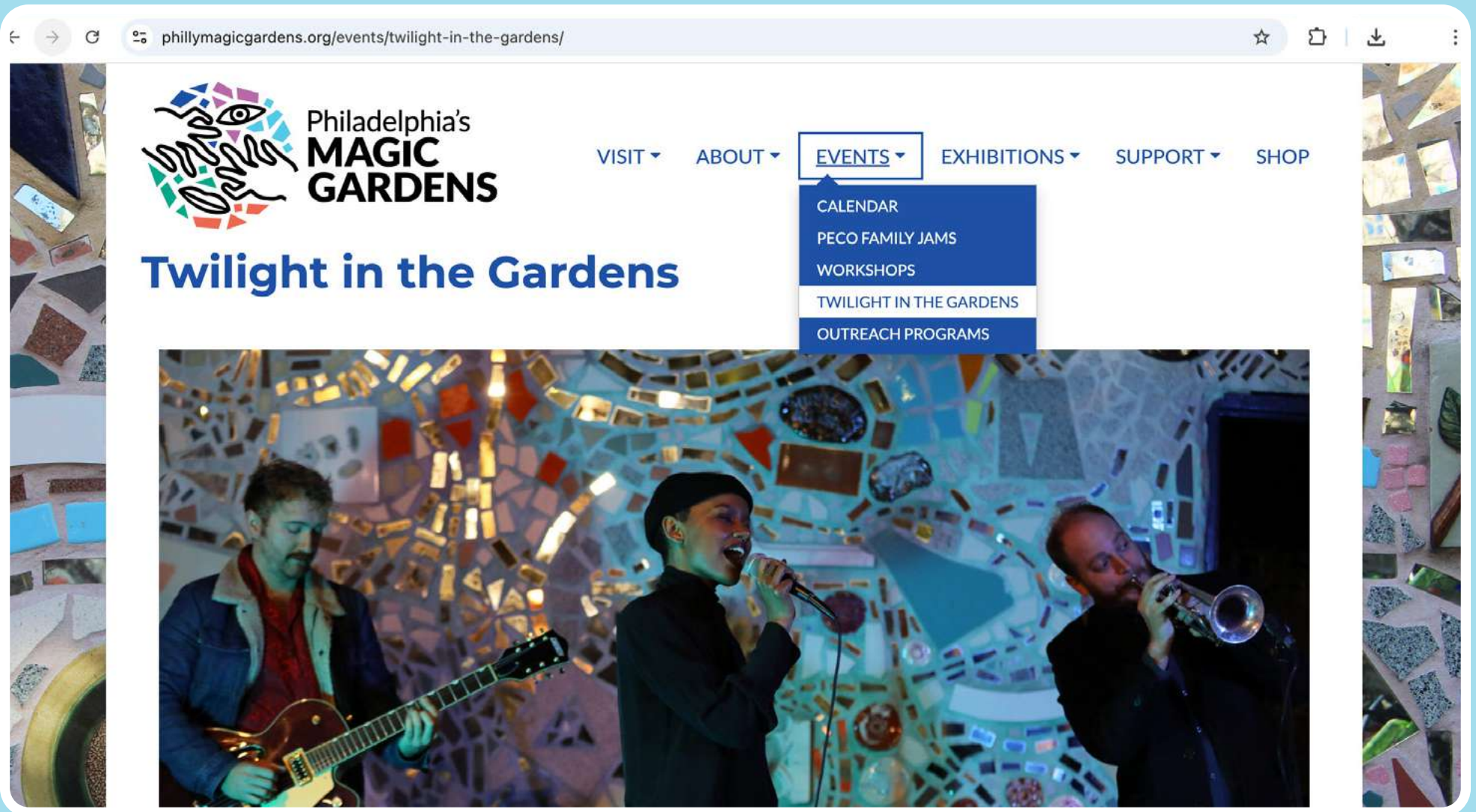
WHAT IS TWILIGHT IN THE GARDENS?

Experience the Magic Gardens Museum after hours with a live musical performance and guided art workshop. Each event is unique and the series has a variety of musical genres and art experiences. Guests are encouraged to bring a blanket, snacks, and drinks to get comfortable and picnic.



WHEN DOES TWILIGHT IN THE GARDENS TAKE PLACE?

Twilight in the Gardens takes place every fourth Friday from May - October, from 7:00 - 10:00 p.m. at the Magic Gardens Museum (1020 South Street)



HOW SHOULD I GET TICKETS?

Tickets for each Twilight in the Gardens event go on sale online two weeks ahead of time at phillymagicgardens.org. These events do sell out, so we encourage you to purchase your tickets online before arriving. Tickets cost \$30 / Adults, \$25 / Students & Seniors, and \$20 / PMG Members.



ARRIVING

You'll enter the Museum through the front door at 1020 South Street. Guests can arrive starting at 7:00 p.m. A staff member will be inside to check your name off the will call list.



VISITING THE GALLERIES

The whole Museum is open to explore, including our two indoor galleries. You are welcome to view our current exhibition.

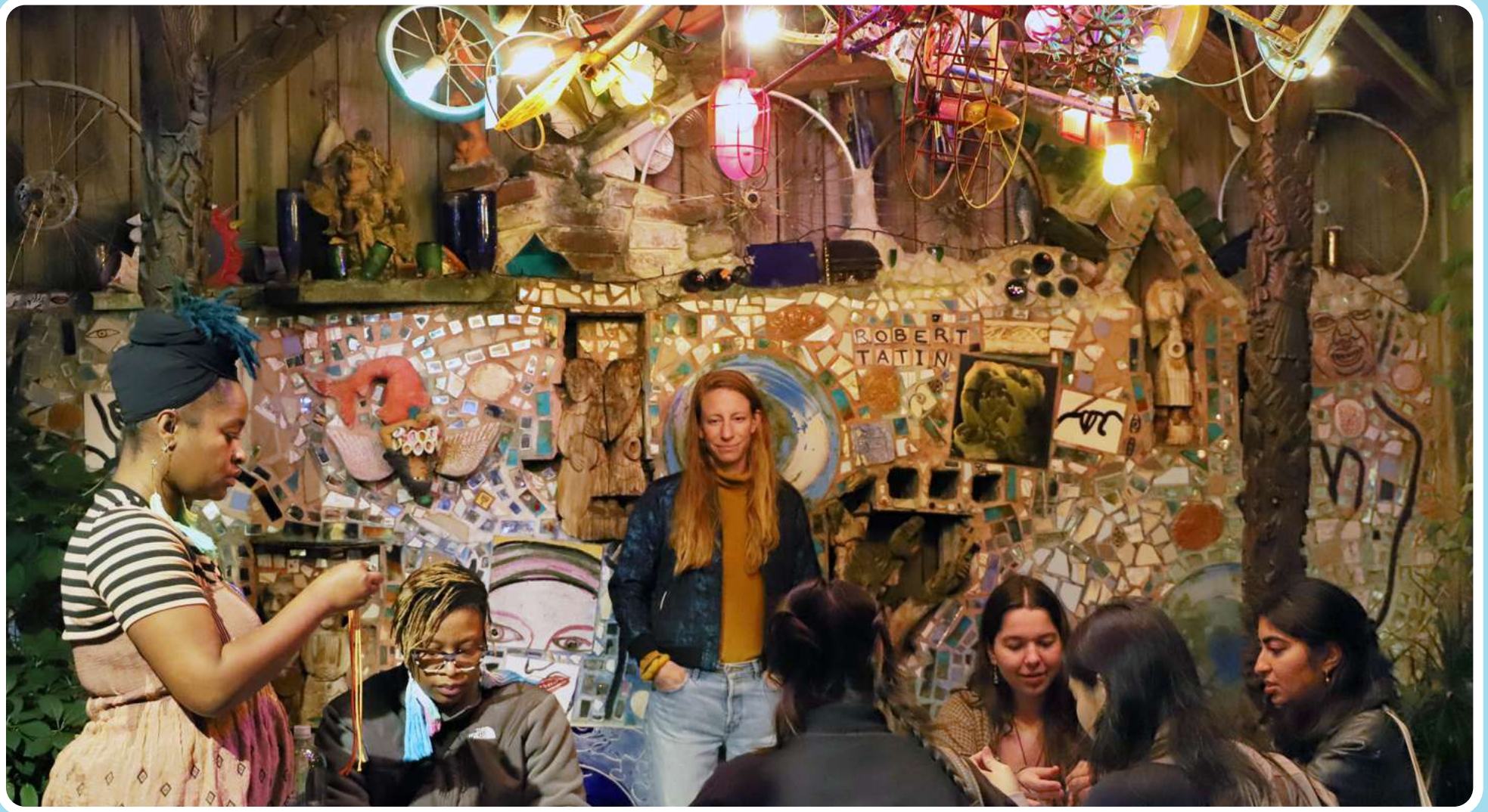


THE BASEMENT

The mosaicked basement is also open to discover. The door to access this area is in the gift shop inside the Museum. The mosaicked basement is accessible by a narrow staircase. An Eye Spy game and drawing activity are available to do.



You are welcome to find a spot to picnic anywhere indoors or outdoors. You can bring your choice of food and beverages to enjoy.



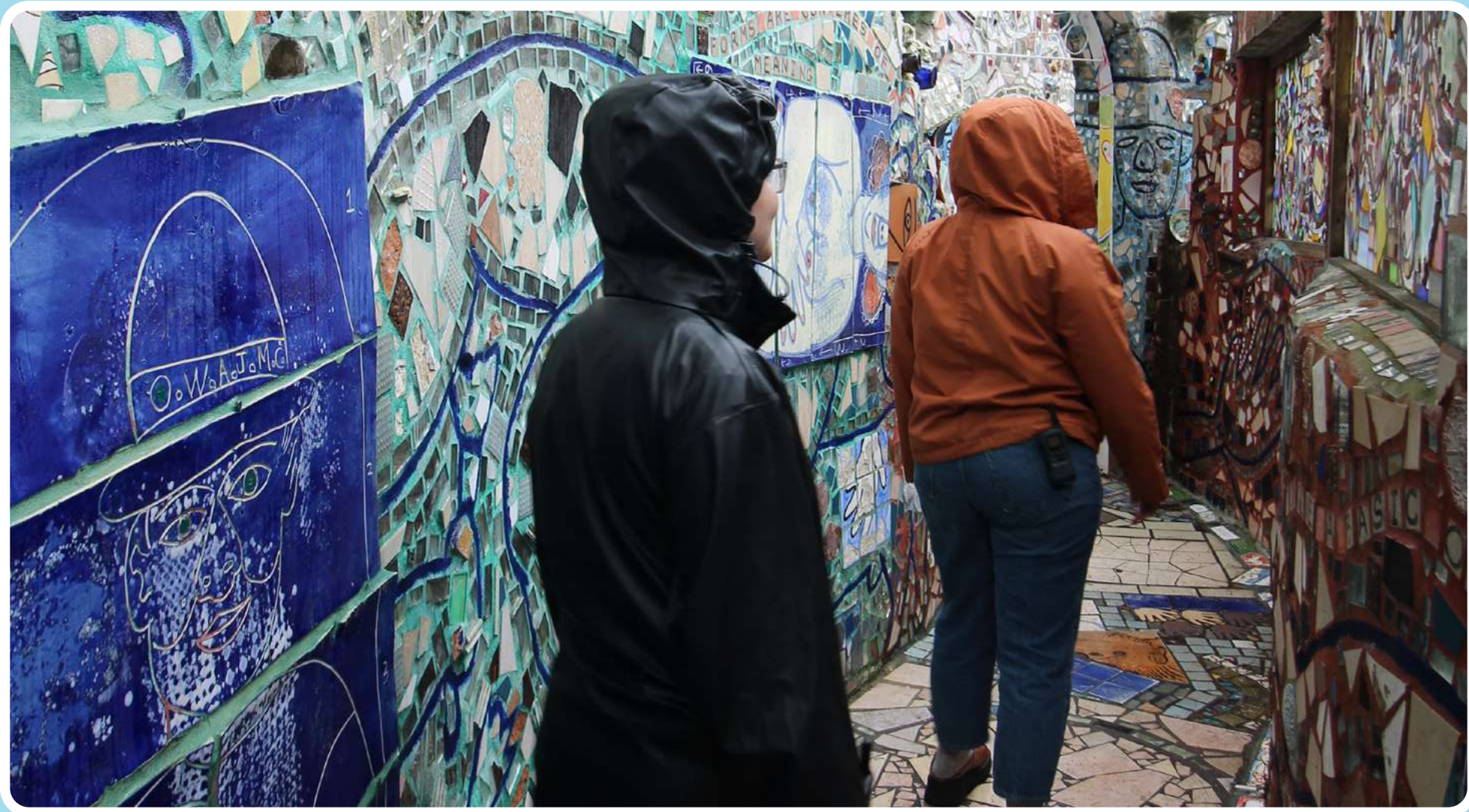
ART ACTIVITY

The art activity takes place outside under a covered area. Each event has a different activity. A Teaching Artist and volunteers will be there to help guide you in the activity. You may have to wait for an open seat at the table. Most activities take around 15 minutes to complete. Some people take more or less time. You will be able to take your art home with you.



PERFORMANCE

The musical performance takes place from 8:00 - 9:00 p.m. in the courtyard. Some chairs and floor cushions are available to sit on. You are encouraged to bring your own blanket to sit on to watch the performance.



WEATHER

Rainy weather may delay the start of the performance. If the rain is heavy or there is a thunderstorm the event may be canceled. If that happens, you will be notified via email and your ticket will be refunded.
